



Document 3 - Group Policy - Counterfeit, Fraudulent and Suspect Items (CFSI)

Tinsley Bridge Group recognises that counterfeiting is a serious global problem that affects companies worldwide and that there are parties who may seek to substitute CFSI for genuine items or services for commercial gain. Tinsley Bridge Group endeavours to make all employees and partners aware of the risks of CFSI.

To protect our customers, we have implemented a proactive and comprehensive counterfeit prevention policy for all purchases entering or leaving our site. To help prevent the purchase of counterfeit, suspect or unapproved products, we purchase components directly from:

- 1) OEM's or CEM's
- 2) Franchised Distributors
- 3) Manufacturer or Agent

Suppliers to Tinsley Bridge Group are required to adopt this policy and this is mandatory to the contract

Certain hard-to-find or obsolete products cannot always be obtained from these primary sources. In such instances, it may be necessary to source components through brokers or independent distributors. In these cases, Tinsley Bridge Group approved vendors shall only be used.

To continually verify vendor quality, we carefully monitor the ongoing performance of all suppliers utilizing a variety of criteria, including rigorous inspection procedures; utilising test house partners. These are detailed within our ISO 9001 procedures.
